

End of Life Care and Advance Care Planning for Outpatients with Inoperable Aortic Aneurysms

A Multicentre Cohort Study

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METHOD – Non-operatively managed Aortic Aneurysms

COHORT:

- 220 patients not offered aortic aneurysm repair in Leeds and Maastricht between 2017 and 2021. (AAA >55mm, TAAA >60mm)
- A total of 1506 patients who had been through the clinic in this time.

OUTCOMES:

Survival time

Cause of death

PC referral and consultation

PC consultation to death or to date of audit time

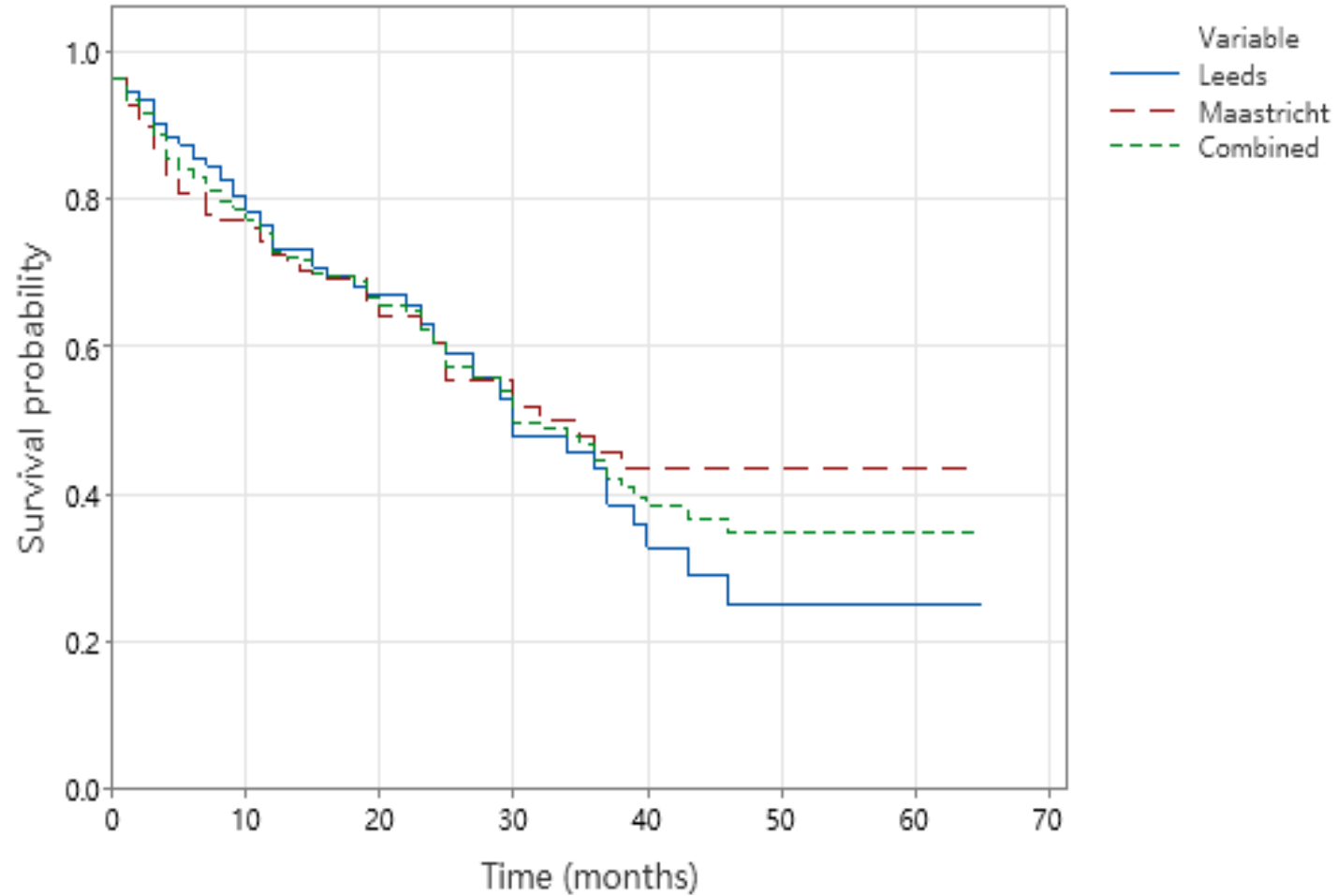
DNACPR and ReSPECT forms and place of death

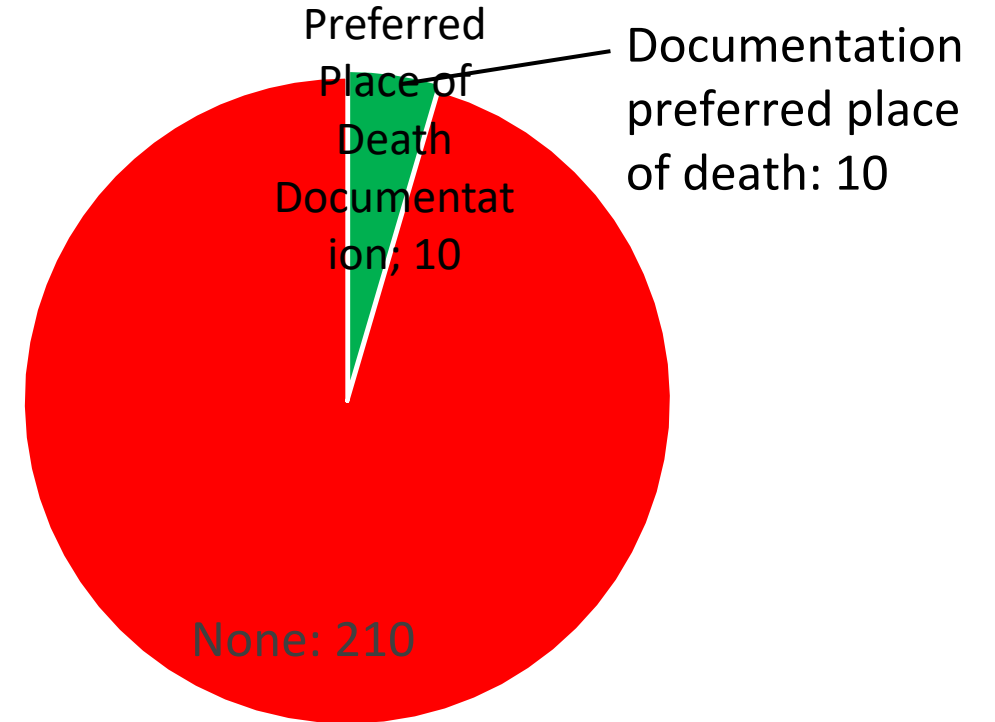
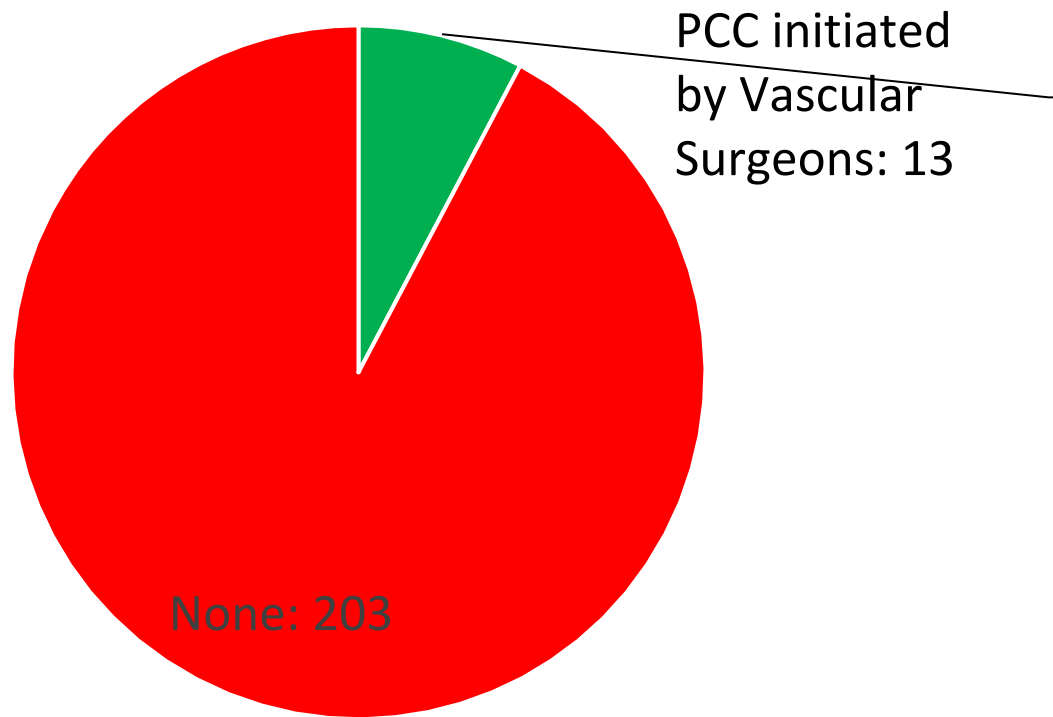
Unplanned admission to hospital
